Vehicle Ramming Attack

A ramming attack involves using a vehicle to harm pedestrians or damage buildings/vehicles.

The vehicle may be driven at high speed, and explosive devices or firearms may be used.

Attacks often occur in pedestrian or restricted areas, using barriers for access. As ordinary vehicles are used, attacks are not easily identifiable before they happen.

BEFORE

1 BE AWARE of vehicles around you and watch for signs of reckless or unusual behavior.

DURING

2 RUN

If a vehicle appears to be heading towards pedestrians, try to get out of the way and leave the potential attack area.

3 HIDE

If escape is not possible, seek cover behind objects or structures.

AFTER

4 SURVIVE

Watch for secondary attacks, such as those carried out by the driver or additional individuals.

Before providing assistance to the injured, assess the scene for any remaining threats.

Call emergency services as soon as it is safe to do so.
