Active Shooter Attack

An active shooter uses firearms to harm or kill people in both confined and open areas.

They are unpredictable and can rapidly change their tactics.

Targets may be chosen randomly.

Be aware of your surroundings and pay attention to exit signage and escape routes when entering enclosed spaces.

DURING

1 RUN

Move away from the shooter's position.

If possible, evacuate the building, and stay aware of the shooter's location.

2 HIDE

If evacuation is not possible, hide in a secure room and barricade the door.

Keep away from windows and doors, remain quiet, and stay low to the ground.

AFTER

3 SURVIVE

As a last resort, use improvised weapons to defend yourself if the shooter is close.

Only call emergency services when it is safe to do so.

Follow the instructions of the authorities and evacuate the area if instructed to do so.
